SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 0 - Departure – Travel day

Day 1 - LONDON

Upon arrival, meet and greet by an English-speaking local tour guide, who will accompany you along the whole itinerary. Starting at Trafalgar Square, the hub of London with Nelson's column, you will pass towards some of the most important sights of London: National Gallery, Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, where the most English Kings and Queen have been crowned since 1066, St. James Park, Buckingham Palace and Harrods. Dinner and Overnight.

Day 2 - LONDON

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet with your local guide to visit the eastern part of London: Somerset House, St. Clement Danes, Temple Church and St. Paul's Cathedral, Tower of London and Tower Bridge.



Free time to walk around. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 3 - LONDON - WINDSOR - BATH

After breakfast departure with the bus to WINDSOR. Here you can appreciate the majesty of Windsor Castle with its towers and beautiful chapels. Lunch on your own. Continue the road to BATH, a city founded by the Romans, who used the area's thermal springs to create a spa retreat. Here you can admire the Roman Baths complex, the Bath Abbey, a huge medieval church that you can climb to the top, and the city's Georgian masterpieces such as Pulteney Bridge and Royal Crescent. Dinner and overnight in hotel.



Day 4 - OXFORD - CAMBRIDGE

After breakfast, departure with the bus in direction of OXFORD, known for its world-famous university and for its various locations used in Harry Potter movies. Visit the Oxford College. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon continue the road to CAMBRIDGE, another important European university city. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 5 CAMBRIDGE

After breakfast, time to discover CAMBRIDGE. Here a walking tour of the university is a must. You could visit art galleries (from the contemporary to the classic), or see a drama play at the theatre. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon you could enjoy an excursion along the River Cam using the traditional Cambridge Punt.

Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – CAMBRIDGE - CANTERBURY

After breakfast, departing to CANTERBURY. This city is one of England's most attractive and important cathedral cities, with its star building considered one of the finest in Europe. Canterbury Cathedral is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Being the seat of the Archbishop of Canterbury, leader of the Church of England, is the most important Christian site in the country. Just outside, you can see the ruins of the sixth century St Augustine's Abbey. Dinner and overnight in Hotel.



Day 7 - DOVER - HASTINGS - BRIGHTON

After breakfast, departure to DOVER, a strategic city along all history due to the proximity to France. Visit of the harbour, cliffs, city centre and the medieval Castle. Continue the road to HASTINGS, a city known in Europe history with William the Conqueror. In the afternoon, continue with the visit of BRIGHTON along the southern coast. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 8-DEPART FOR HOME

After breakfast, in due time transfer to London airport to depart with your return flight.
